




### PLACEMENT ACCURACY: WHAT WE KNOW

- Analysis of urban system data predicted that 29% of all entering students are assigned to developmental English based on COMPASS scores but could have earned a B or better in college-level English
- And that 18% of students assigned to developmental math based on COMPASS scores could have gotten a B or better in college-level Math



- Percentage of students underplaced
- Percentage of students assigned to remediation

3 Levels Below	15%	8%




### Time to Complete College Level Math Course: *Statway*™ vs. Traditional Statistics
