## PLACEMENT ACCURACY: WHAT WE KNOW

Analysis of urban system data predicted that $29 \%$ of all entering students are assigned to developmental English based on COMPASS scores but could have earned a B or better in college-level English

And that 18\% of students assigned to developmental math based on COMPASS scores could have gotten a B or better in college-level
